Who will sit at Jesus' right hand?

Mark 10:35-37, 39 & 40 Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to Him, saying, "Teacher, we want You to do for us whatever we ask." ³⁶ And He said to them, "What do you want Me to do for you?" ³⁷ They said to Him, "Grant us that we may sit, one on Your right hand and the other on Your left, in Your glory." Jesus said to them, "You will indeed drink the cup that I drink, and with the baptism I am baptized with you will be baptized; ⁴⁰ "but to sit on My right hand and on My left is not Mine to give, but <u>it</u> is for those for whom it is prepared."

Jesus said that this honor will be given to them for who it is prepared. Consider the possibility that this honor is reserved for a woman. For example, could it be reserved for someone like Mary Magdalen who was a former demon possessed harlot?
