

“Salvation” (the word) Pop Quiz

Below are several New Testament verses that have something to do with salvation. To take this quiz, read each verse and then indicate to the right of each verse whether the salvation being discussed has something to do with: a) what has already occurred in the life of the Christian, b) what is happening during the life of the Christian, or c) is something that will happen to the Christian when Jesus comes back to judge the world. **Depending on syntax and context, these words can mean many things. This fact might make this quiz challenging.** If you think it is appropriate for some answers, use two of the letters. (For example, A/B or B/C.) I have underlined the part of the verse that you should mainly consider. At the end, there is a link to a document that contains answers.

Note: The verses selected have either the noun form or verb form of the Greek word for salvation. (Soteria = noun form, sozo = verb form)

Save (verb):

1. Matthew 10:22 You will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end will be saved.

2. Acts 2:21 And it shall come to pass *That* whoever calls on the name of the LORD Shall be saved.'

3. Acts 2:47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

4. Acts 15:10-11 "Now therefore, why do you test God by putting a yoke on the neck of the disciples which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?" But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved in the same manner as they."

5. Acts 16:31 So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."

6. Romans 5:9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

7. Romans 5:10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

8. Romans 8:24 For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees?

9. Romans 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

10. Romans 10:13 For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved."

11. 1 Corinthians 1:18 For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

12. 1 Corinthians 3:15 If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

13. 1 Corinthians 15:1-2 Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you -- unless you believed in vain.

14. 2 Corinthians 2:15 For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.

15. Ephesians 2:8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God,

16. 1 Timothy 4:16 Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you.

17. 2 Timothy 1:9 who has saved us and called *us* with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,

18. Titus 3:5 not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,

19. Hebrews 7:25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

20. James 1:21 Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

21. James 2:14 What *does it* profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him?

22. 1 Peter 4:18 Now "If the righteous one is scarcely saved, Where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?"

Salvation (noun):

23. Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.

24. Romans 10:10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

25. Romans 13:11 And *do* this, knowing the time, that now *it is* high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer than when we *first* believed.

26. Philippians 1:28 and not in any way terrified by your adversaries, which is to them a proof of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that from God.

27. Philippians 2:12-13 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for *His* good pleasure.

28. Thessalonians 5:8-9 But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and *as* a helmet the hope of salvation. For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,

29. 2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth,

30. 2 Timothy 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

31. 2 Timothy 3:15 and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

32. Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?

33. Hebrews 2:3 how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard *Him*,

34. Hebrews 2:10 For it was fitting for Him, for whom *are* all things and by whom *are* all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

35. Hebrews 5:9 And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him,

36. Hebrews 9:28 so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

37. 1 Peter 1:5 who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

38. 1 Peter 1:8-9 whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see *Him*, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, receiving the end of your faith -- the salvation of your souls.

39. Revelation 12:10 Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down.
