

The SCOT Gospel of John and Revelation was produced by Stones Cry Out Ministries (translation by Tom Bear) to fill a special evangelism ministry need. Because of world events, more people are beginning to wonder if the world is coming to an end. Though we may not have all the answers to their questions, we can suggest they read the book of Revelation. God can use the book of Revelation to increase their concern about the coming judgment. For people who seem to have a genuine desire to learn about God and His salvation plan and the coming judgment, the SCOT Gospel of John and Revelation is perfect. Not only does it include a solid version of the Gospel of John and Revelation, it also includes a concise summary of the Bible's redemption message in the back. If God the Father is drawing a person to Jesus, the SCOT Gospel of John and Revelation provides all the truth necessary as he or she transitions from the kingdom of darkness into the Kingdom of Light. The SCOT Gospel of John and Revelation is a translation from the original Greek Byzantine Textform, sometimes referred to as the Majority Greek Text. It is a precise translation of the original Greek text. It is not a revision of a previous English version, nor is it a paraphrase. The translation is more literal, word-for-word as opposed to the thought-for-thought approach utilized in many other versions today. To help Christians evaluate the SCOT Gospel of John and Revelation text, a Kindle version is offered (99-cents) with more detailed information (for evaluation purposes), including many critical notes. (Many of those notes would not be appropriate for a Gospel that is used for evangelism, so they do not appear in the paperback edition.)
