Why do Muslims think the Bible has been corrupted?

I have had thousands of face to face gospel conversations with Muslims. During a majority of them, I hear them tell me that the Bible is corrupt. Logically, if the Bible is corrupt, its entire message is called into question. They think to themselves, "Why should I believe anything this guy is telling me since his book is corrupt?" The gospel holds everyone accountable to obey it. But Satan uses their false view of it to turn their attention away from the gospel and thus, keep them blind to it so that they might perish.

Why do Muslim's think the Bible has been corrupted? Most of them have no real knowledge of the subject. They simply listen to what their leaders teach them. They are taught by their leaders that the Bible has been corrupted. Most of them accept that narrative and feel justified in their belief that Islam is the true religion. Rarely, a Muslim will go online and watch videos to learn more about this. But typically, they will watch videos made by Muslims that only further cement their view that the Bible is corrupt.
